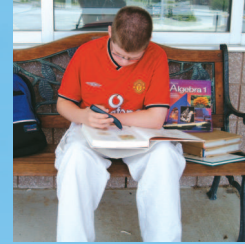


# New Readingpen® Basic Edition

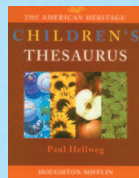
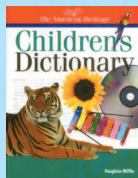

Used just like a yellow highlighter, the Readingpen® Basic Edition allows the user to scan a word they have difficulty recognizing and hear it spoken aloud through the integrated speaker or headphones and see it displayed in large characters on the built in screen.

If hearing the word spoken is not sufficient to recognize it, then the user can see the word broken down into syllables, have a simple and easy to understand definition displayed.

If required, the user can hear the definition spoken aloud or see and hear words with a similar meaning from the Thesaurus – allowing them to get as much or as little help as they need to achieve a smoother, more continuous reading flow and an increase in comprehension of the text.

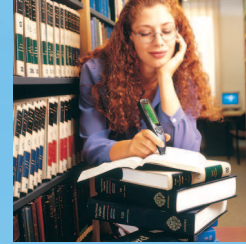

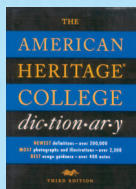
