

Responsibilities of CCBC League Captains Fall 2023

1. Captains represent their team and the club and are responsible for the actions of their players.
2. Captains are responsible for having a working knowledge of league rules and ethically enforcing them while providing their team members with an enjoyable bocce experience. **This includes promoting good sportsmanship.**
3. The Club encourages new membership, and it is the responsibility of captains to provide guidance and instruction to members of their team who are new to the Club.
4. Captains shall provide their team members copies of the league match play schedule. **There will be no make-up games.** A team can play with 3 members, but games will not be rescheduled unless there is a league wide issue.
5. Captains will meet to agree on who will be judges of “inside” balls before the start of the match.
6. If a captain is unable to attend a match, the captain must assign an acting captain to represent the team. It is the captain’s responsibility to ensure the acting captain has read and understands the League Rules and the Captain’s Responsibilities.
7. Matches must end 2 hours after the scheduled start time. Captains will be responsible for monitoring this.
8. At the end of the match, **both** captains will be asked to electronically notify the CCBC Operations Director of the scores before leaving the court. In the Fall 2023 League, both wins and losses and scores must be provided.
9. The captains for the last match on each court for that day are responsible for returning equipment to the proper storage area. If you are playing the last match of the day, please check that all equipment is stored and locked.
